

Quick Start Guide: Setting Up StatBroadcast on your StatCrew Scoring Computer

Please note: this guide and download applies to StatCrew and other XML output scoring software setups only. If you are using NCAA LiveStats, please refer to our setup guide specific to that software.

Transmitting stats to StatBroadcast for live viewing requires an application on your scoring computer called StatBroadcast Broadcastr and some minimal configuration steps to work with StatCrew:

Download and Installs

do this immediately on your scoring computer:

- 1. **Update your StatCrew software to this year's latest version** The latest version is required for the live XML function
- 2. **Download and install StatBroadcast Broadcastr** 10.0 or higher Download instructions can be found on the following page

Initial Sport Setup

do this the first time you install a StatCrew update for each sport on each scoring computer:

- Launch the StatBroadcast Broadcastr app. You will be prompted to select your version of StatCrew. Select 'YES' to indicate you are using StatCrew Legacy. If prompted to load a new event, select 'No'.
- 2. Press the the dark gray button labeled 'Configure StatCrew.' (on the right side). This function will attempt to configure your StatCrew settings and create a folder for XML Select your corresponding StatCrew sport.
- 3. Press OK once you received the 'Configured successfully' message.

Game day Setup

do this before every game (make sure to follow all six steps):

- 1. Open up **StatCrew Game Reports** and select your game.
- 2. From the Live menu, choose Live Setup and in the popup window, check the box next to Activate and press OK.

From the Live menu, select 'Send stats files'.

- 3. Launch **StatBroadcast Broadcastr** and **press 'Yes'** when asked to load a new event. After logging in, **select your event** from the list and press **'Load Configuration'**.
- 4. Press the green button labeled 'Start Transmitting'
- 5. Score your game in StatCrew



Postgame – Optional steps

do this after your game is completed and you have entered final information in StatCrew (duration, records, etc.)

- 1. Click the red **Stop Transmitting** button
- 2. Click the purple Wrap Up Event button.
- 3. Change the Event Status from 'Not Completed' to 'Completed'
- 4. To create an event archive (generate final book and preserve stats), check 'Create Archive'
- 5. If you wish to submit a final XML file to the NCAA, check 'Submit File to NCAA'
 - You must enter the home and away team RPI codes if they were not automatically detected - To submit, you must be either the Home or Away team in the file.
 - Enter your NCAA Stats submission password in the box to authorize the transmission
- 6. If you wish to send final stats PDF to a distribution list, check the box and select your list from the dropdown.
- 7. Press **Save** and close Broadcastr once wrap up completes.

Downloading StatBroadcast Broadcastr 10.0

Version 10.0 or higher is strongly recommended for the 2019-20 academic year.

The software download is available at :

http://software.statbroadcast.com

Note: You will need Administrator Access to your computer to install this software. If you are receiving errors overwriting files, you may need your Campus IT staff to temporarily unlock your computer.

We recommend updating your StatCrew installation before setting up Broadcastr. Installing a StatCrew update for a sport will erase your 'Live Setup' settings and require Broadcastr to go through the configuration process again.

Reminder to Upgrade Your StatCrew Software for 2019-20

StatCrew Software automatically disables its ability to generate live stats XML files on July 31, 2019 and you will receive a 'License Expired' message on trying to start an event.

StatCrew 2019-20 licenses are available for purchase from statcrew.com

In order to run live stats on any XML-based platform (including StatBroadcast, CBS, Neulion, Sidearm, Presto, etc.), you will need to purchase and install the 2018 update to your StatCrew software from http://www.statcrew.com.

Please note: StatBroadcast is not affiliated with StatCrew software.



Troubleshooting Common Broadcastr Issues

Previous game's live stats are showing

Try each of these steps to resolve

- Exit StatCrew Game Reports and reopen. Be sure to re-check Activate in Live Setup
- In Game Reports, change the 'XML filename' on the right; add or increase a number after the current name (ex. event -> event1)
- In Game Reports, make sure Auto-copy files is checked and a location is set in Target Directory
- Make sure the Target Directory set in Game Reports exists on your computer.
- In Broadcastr Advanced Settings -> Transmission Settings, make sure the location of the XML file to transmit matches the following settings in Live Setup: 'XML output Target Directory' + 'XML filename' + .xml

'XML file could not be found'

If an event has not yet started or the destination folder does not exist, StatCrew will not generate an initial XML file to send via FTP.

- 1. Ensure that the 'target directory' specified in Game Reports Live Setup Copy File Settings exists on your computer.
 - Do this opening 'My Computer', looking on the drive you specified (i.e. C:) and looking for the folder (i.e. xml). If the folder does not exist or was not automatically created by Broadcastr, go the file menu and create a new folder.
- 2. Create a pre-game XML file from Stat Crew.

In Game Reports, go to the Live menu and select 'Send Stats Files'.

Note: In TAS Baseball, activating a live stats feed before entering starting lineups for both teams will cause Game Reports to crash.

'No Internet connection available'

If your Broadcastr is able to connect and load an event configuration, but then fails to connect to the FTP servers (showing the error 'An internet connection is not available'), your network may be blocking FTP access.

To switch Broadcastr into HTTP mode:

Press the Advanced Settings button

Check the box next to 'Enable HTTP Mode for Transmissions'

Press Save and try transmitting again.

In HTTP compatibility mode, your XML files will be transmitted to our servers first via HTTP (webpage) and then FTP'd to your assigned destinations.
